## NAR Sustainability Symposium in Boise to Celebrate Impact of Planting of 215,000 Trees, Address Sustainability in Idaho

Event Friday, April 14 will explore how local sustainability policies and programs impact property development and sales

BOISE, ID (April 4, 2023) – The National Association of Realtors<sup>®</sup> will host a sustainability symposium – <u>NAR</u> <u>Community and Stewardship: Boise, Idaho</u> – Friday, April 14, 3-6 p.m. Mountain at The Grove Hotel, Grand Ballroom, located at 245 S Capitol Blvd in Boise.

The sustainability event will celebrate the planting of 215,000 trees in National Forests throughout Idaho this year, including an announcement about impact. The trees will support reforestation efforts in the Boise and Nez-Perce Clearwater National Forests to bolster recovery from the 2016 Pioneer Fire and the 2021 Johnson Creek Fire. This planting is part of NAR's partnership with the National Forest Foundation on a 1.575 million tree-planting initiative.

The symposium will include two panel discussions. *Sustainability and the State of Idaho* will explore sustainability issues that impact Idaho and how they are being addressed. *Residential Resilience and Community Stewardship* will explore how local initiatives, policies and programs directly impact the development, purchase and sale of property. Attendees will hear from business and community leaders and real estate professionals regarding initiatives being developed in Idaho that will promote residential resilience and environmental stewardship.
